4. <u>Management Reports</u>

4.1 Operations

Mr. Kolisz reported that the District responded to 22 Underground Service Alerts, had 0 water main and service line leaks, painted 45 fire hydrants, and had 1 blown meter. There have been a total of six water main leaks for the calendar year. Production is down 10%. The treatment plant has approximately a 3% treatment water loss. The emergency generator is expected to be online in a couple of weeks once the electrical is completed.

4.2 Finance

Ms. Alaniz reminded the Board that, due to the implementation of the Springbrook accounting system and audit, June Financials will be included in the August agenda packet.

4.3 General Manager

Tamara Alaniz met with the Action Council for 29 Palms regarding the possible placement of a mural on the Hansen reservoir on Utah Trail. The Council is considering commemorating the 100 year anniversary of the National Park Service Act. The State Water Resources Control Board passed regulations mandating water districts enact their Water Shortage Contingency Plans and gives water districts the authority to impose fines on water abusers. The District has been proactive in sending out letters to potentially affected customer accounts informing them of the prohibited activities and providing recommended alternative uses.
