Firefighters made contact with approximately 1,000 young children during Fire Prevention Week. The Open House in conjunction with CMC Fire Technology Club at Fire Station 422 welcomed

approximately 200 people. The pancake breakfast served 673 people making over \$3,800 for the Fire Explorers. Chief Thompson recognized two Explorers, Jacob Bell and Paige Rossi, who attended the leadership academy and improved their positions.
